## NEET - MDS 2018



National Board of Examinations

### (For admission to MDS 2018 Academic Session)

- NEET-MDS 2018 is a single window entrance examination for all Dental PG courses - 2018 Admission Session. No other entrance examination, either at state or institution level, shall be valid for entry to MDS Courses.
- NBE shall be conducting **NEET-MDS** as a Computer Based Test (CBT) on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 in a single session at all the test centres.

### Eligibility Criteria for NEET-MDS 2018

- A candidate for admission to the Master in Dental Surgery courses, must possess a recognised degree of Bachelor in Dental Surgery awarded by a university or institute in India and registered with the State Dental Council and has obtained provisional or permanent registration and has undergone compulsory rotating internship of one year in an approved recognised dental college. The cutoff date for completion of internship towards determination of eligibility for appearing in **NEET-MDS 2018** shall be 31st March, 2018.

### Applying for NEET-MDS 2018

- Candidates can register for **NEET-MDS** through online portal from 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2017 to 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. Candidates can choose the exam city through online registration system on first come first serve basis.

### Examination Fee

General (BC) Candidates ₹ 1500/-

SC/ST/PwD/ OBCs Candidates ₹ 2500/-

- The fee for the examination has to be remitted through payment gateway, at the time of online submission of application form, using credit card or debit card issued by Banks in India or through internet banking.
