4. STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITION

- Semi Final Rounds
- Final Round

5. LANGUAGE

The language of the Competition shall be English.

6. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 6.1. Universities/Law schools/Colleges/ Institutes, recognized by the Bar Council of India, are eligible to participate in the National Moot Court Competition, 2020.
- 6.2. The students pursuing Three Year or Five Year Undergraduate LL.B. degree course shall be eligible to participate in this competition.

7. TEAM COMPOSITION

- 7.1. The team composition for the competition shall be comprised of three (3) members; two of them shall be designated as speaker and one researcher.
- 7.2. The researcher may be permitted to argue as a speaker in case of illness or any unforeseen event but the permission of the moot court convener in such case shall be mandatory.

8. DRESS CODE

- 8.1. Participants are required to adhere to the following dress code during the competition:
Ladies: White shirt, black trousers/skirts, black tie, black coat and black shoes.

Gentlemen: White Shirt, black trousers, black tie along with black coat and black shoes.

8.2. Strict adherence to the dress code is solicited. Failure will result in disqualification.

9. SCOUTING

9.1. Teams shall not be allowed to observe the oral submissions of any other team. Scouting is strictly prohibited.
