Enrollment Process

1. Online Registration (The registration link will be shared through respective departments/schools)
2. Submission of Registration & Enrollment Form along with necessary documents on the day of NCC Enrollment
3. Allotment of Chest No.
4. Physical Examination
5. Physical Efficiency Test
6. Written Examination
7. Group Discussion/Personal Interview
8. Preparation of Merit List
9. Final Selection based on Merit
10. Filling out the Online Enrollment Form

Qualification and Eligibility Criteria for Enrollment in the Senior Division **(Preference should be given to NCC B-Certificate Holders)**

1. Maximum 23 Years of age as on the date of enrollment (Student should not born before August 2001).
2. Height:
 - a. Girls: 5'2''
 - b. Boys: 5'8''
3. Should be a 1st year student in UG Course of the BBD University.
4. Should be a citizen of India or a subject of Nepal.
5. Should be on the rolls of the College/University.
6. Not convicted of offence involving moral turpitude.
7. Not have been dismissed from NCC/ Territorial Army/Indian Army.
8. Not a member of organization with anti national/subservient activities.
9. Should be of good moral character.
10. Satisfy the standard of physical fitness in height, chest measurement and other aspects as given in Appendix 'A' to Govt. of India, MoD letter No. 0162/49/NCC dated 19 Mar 1949.
