ACTIVITIES

Typically performed outdoors, it utilizes minimal props and focuses on impactful dialogue and gestures. Its accessibility and interactive nature engage audiences directly, making it a powerful medium to address issues ranging from gender equality and environmental sustainability to political awareness. The modern use of Nukkad Natak as a tool for social awareness and change gained prominence during the Indian theater movement of the 1970s.

MONOLOGUE: A monologue is a solo performance where one person speaks, expressing thoughts, emotions, or a narrative. Often found in theater and film, monologues offer insights into a character's inner world, delivering powerful speeches, reflections, or stories that engage the audience with the depth of the performer's words and emotions.

MONOACT: Monoact is a theatrical performance where a single actor portrays multiple characters within a single act. Through voice modulation, body language, and costume changes, the performer transforms to convey distinct personas, often presenting a compelling story or theme. Monoact showcases the actor's versatility and ability to inhabit various roles in a captivating manner.

STAND-UP : Stand-up comedy is a solo performance art where comedians deliver humorous monologues directly to the audience. Through witty observations, personal anecdotes, and jokes, they tackle a wide range of topics, often commenting on everyday life, societal issues, and their own experiences. The goal is to entertain and evoke laughter from the audience.

STAGE PLAY: A stage play is a live theatrical performance where actors perform a scripted story on a designated stage. Combining dialogue, actions, and set designs, stage plays entertain and engage audiences with narratives, emotions, and themes. They offer a unique blend of visual and auditory storytelling, bringing characters and plots to life through live performances.

PARODY: A parody is a creative work that humorously imitates or mocks an original piece, often exaggerating its characteristics or style for comedic effect.
